

## **Some Writers Have Mastered the Secret of Getting Paid Six Figures or More...Why Not You? Why Not Today?**

Is it really possible to make a living as a writer? To find out I asked several writers I know how they did it.

### **Many Roads to the Writer's Life**

My friend Sherri put aside dreams of a writing career to take care of her mother and son.

While working as a teacher, she dreamed of a writing career that would make money but had no idea how she could do that. Then she saw some of my writing - a simple sales letter. She thought she could write one too and that might be the path to making money from writing.

Sherri took several courses and went to an in-person writing workshop. Sherri used the ideas she learned to land her first client. Soon she signed a client deal that was worth more than she'd made from writing to date.

Another friend, Penny, was a working mom employed as an administrative assistant in sales and marketing. Although she wrote a lot in her job, Penny wanted to have the freedom to make her own schedule. She took a writing course and attended an in-person workshop.

Using the writing principles she learned, Penny submitted a writing assignment to a potential client. The client paid her \$5,000 for it and immediately gave her another assignment for the same amount. Penny went on to get many assignments from other clients.

Yet another friend, Liz, had burned out after 11 years as a full-time CPA. She wanted more out of life than eating, sleeping and working. Liz wanted to spend more time with her husband, who was soon to retire. She wanted work that would let them live where they wanted, not where there were jobs.

She joined a writer's club and learned several ways to get clients. Putting her new knowledge to work, Liz followed up with a lead she'd found on a social networking site and landed her first client. Even better, it was a steady client for writing blog posts. That job led to her to a successful career writing for other CPA firms.



Finally, I'd like you to meet my friend Steve who's now a full-time writer. A short time before he started his writing business, Steve was on his way to a job interview. The job would increase his family's standard of living only slightly.

As he was rushing out the door, two of his younger sons wanted hugs and kisses. All he could manage was a hug on the run. Steve then overheard the older son telling the younger one "Daddy doesn't have time for kisses today". He vowed then and there to find something to do that would pay the bills but allow him more time with his family.

Shortly thereafter Steve took a writing course and joined a writer's club. He knew he would make it as a writer when he received his first check from a company he'd submitted an assignment to.

He now has a six-figure writing business in both the natural health and survival niches.

### **My Experience**

I always wanted to write but had no idea how to make it pay. I finally found the answer. It started with a life-changing letter...a letter telling me about a little-known, high-paying writing skill.
